Dear Parents of Kindergarten through 5th grade students at Blessed Sacrament Catholic School

This letter gives information about our school uniforms.

Our school uniform guidelines include navy blue dress pants or shorts with no cargo/extra pockets and no denim material. Polo type shirts (short or long-sleeved) are to be white or light blue with no other accent colors or company logos visible. At this time there will be no additional items or colors added to our current selection.

French Toast and Schoolbelles will continue to be our primary authorized uniform suppliers. However, buying uniform items from local retailers will now be allowed as well. Kohl's, Wal-Mart, Sears, and semi-local Old Navy and Gap, for example, all have uniform lines that support our uniform guidelines. If you choose an alternate supplier, our uniform guidelines must continue to be adhered to, with no exceptions.

The Schoolbelles catalogue, their link to their website is <http://www.schoolbelles.com/myschool/M37/S1252>. This is specific to Blessed Sacrament and only lists items that are approved. Schoolbelles will continue to embroider our school crest on polo type shirts only (excluding all pocketed apparel items) and will continue to sew the name "Blessed Sacrament" on polo's and turtlenecks.

On the reverse are the items in the French Toast catalogue that fit our uniform code. The source code for French Toast is QS4535R and can be ordered online.

Uniform shorts are also acceptable but are only allowed as indicated on the monthly calendars. All uniform requirements are in the school handbook, please refer to this for any clarifications.

Another opportunity to acquire uniforms are the occasional uniform swaps held in the school throughout the year.

If purchasing clothing from any of these sources presents a financial hardship, please contact the principal for assistance. If you would care to donate money toward helping people with these financial needs please contact the office for information.
