

# **Family-Centered Elementary Faith Formation Program**

- Parents and kids learn and pray together and bring discussion and prayer about their faith all the way home and into their daily lives, with the ultimate goal of building lifelong, faithful, faith-filled Catholics.
- Current enrollment: 82 kids in 53 families.
- As we explore Salvation History, we're building Bible timelines and learning how to look up scripture references. Every class comes with themed crafts, games, and snacks too!
- We're learning about our place in God's plan, and how the little bit we see of God's plan might look like the back side of a fancy sweater, but God sees the intricate design of the beautiful plan that he's creating!
- We've learned about Creation, Adam & Eve, Noah and the Flood, Abraham & Sarah, Joseph, and Moses. This weekend we'll be learning about Samuel and his place in God's plan.
- Instead of a Christmas party this year, we're going to have a Baby Shower for Mary. We'll celebrate with baby shower games and cake! We're collecting items for HIS Restoration Ministries, which serves homeless pregnant women, just like Mary.

- As the middle schoolers are exploring Salvation History, they're working on collaborative paintings for each story and writing their own summaries of each. They'll combine their work into a book at the end of the year.

  - o 26 kids registered
  - o Beginning series on the Paschal Mystery in January
  - o Adoration coming up in collaboration with middle school

- Snack packs will be available for studying teens December 14 & 15


### **Family Fun Events**

### Sacraments

- First Reconciliation prep is underway! We have 19 kids enrolled in Sacramental Prep this year. The kids will celebrate First Reconciliation at their retreat in this coming weekend.
- First Eucharist prep will begin in February with a retreat in April and First Eucharist Masses in May.
- Confirmation prep begins this year with a year of discernment for our 6<sup>th</sup> graders. They'll begin their first of two years of Confirmation classes in their 7<sup>th</sup> grade year, using the *Purpose* curriculum by LifeTeen. We'll collaborate with Assumption on this program, as we do for our Youth Ministry programs.
